NO OTHER WARRANTY GIVEN BY ANY EMPLOYEE, AGENT, DISTRIBUTOR, OR OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY WITH RESPECT TO THIS PRODUCT SHALL BE BINDING ON QUALITY WILDLIFE SERVICES, INC.

You have just received the newest in our line of TOTAL RECALL, Powered with a micro-processor. The world's first and only, that we know of, digital call bird. The features in this model include :

Power source- 4 D Cell **Alkaline** batteries (not included)

The absence of exposed wires

A higher volume-no extra power horn speaker needed

External toggle switches under the speaker allow the operator to change the modes and access the test switch without having to open the unit.

A rope ratchet for attaching the unit to a tree

The call made by the TOTAL RECALL for Bobwhite Quail is the covey-up call used predominately in the fall. Your Total Recall may be equipped with the Bobwhite Quail, Chukar partridge, Hungarian partridge, California Quail or Pheasant depending on the model you ordered.

General Operating Instructions

1. Move the mode switch (left switch) to the desired operating position- every 30 minutes, every 2 hours, or dusk and dawn only.

2. Undo three latches to access the battery compartment. Pull the battery case from the Velcro and install 4 D-cell alkaline batteries in the case. Rest the bottom of the holder to the bottom of the case and press it against the Velcro. Plug in the power connection and close the unit. **MAKE SURE THE CONNECTION IS PLUGGED IN FIRMLY AND SECURELY**

Note: This power supply will last the entire season, if not the entire year. The unit can now be secured to a tree or post using the rope ratchet. (We used Duracell batteries in our power tests.)

Performance

When batteries are installed, the unit will begin issuing a call series of intermittent calls lasting approximately 6 minutes. About every 30 minutes or 2 hours depending on the setting you have chosen, the call series is repeated. As the sun sets and daylight begins to dim, TOTAL RECALL will begin a final call series and shut down for the night. As the sun rises the next morning, the unit will begin to call and operate in the designated mode. If you choose the dusk/dawn setting, the unit will call only at sunrise and sunset.

TIPS:

- Facing the unit toward the East will allow the Total Recall to begin calling about 10-15 minutes before official sunrise and begin its "shut down" call about 10-15 minutes after official sunset.
- For establishing preseason release quail, I use the 2 hour mode.
- Remove the batteries from the holder when not in use for long periods of time.
- If you change the operating mode while the unit is plugged into the power source, it will not change to the new mode until it finishes the previous setting. To change the mode instantly, change the mode setting then activate the test switch..

DEACTIVATION: The only way to completely deactivate the TOTAL RECALL is to disconnect the batteries.

THIS UNIT IS DESIGNED TO OPERATE ON A 6 VOLT DC INPUT ONLY. USE OF A 9 VOLT OR 12 VOLT BATERIES WILL DESTROY THE ELECTRONICS AND VOID THE WARRANTY.
